### Sunday, July 8 - London, England (Southampton)

London is a cosmopolitan city, with all the cultural attractions you'd expect from a world capital

### Monday, July 9 - Guernsey, Channel Islands (St. Peter Port)

Guernsey possesses a mild climate, breathtaking scenery and a peaceful, unspoiled ambience. Castle and forts dot the Guernsey coastline, including German fortifications from World War II.

### Wednesday, July 11 - Dublin, Ireland

### Thursday, July 12 - Liverpool, England

The birthplace of the Beatles, Liverpool is also home to two of the finest neoclassical buildings in Europe. At nearby Port Sunlight, magnate William Lever built a model industrial village and created the Lady Lever Gallery.

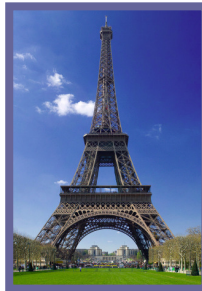
### Friday, July 13 - Belfast, Northern Ireland

### Saturday, July 14 - Glasgow, Scotland (Greenock)

Gothic Glasgow Cathedral survived the Reformation - it's worth a visit, as are Inveraray Castle and the cottage of poet Robert Burns.

### Monday, July 16 - Inverness/Loch Ness, Scotland

Scan the dark waters of the Loch for a sight of Nessie, the Loch Ness Monster. Legend insists that the Loch Ness Monster inhabits a cave beneath the picturesque ruins of Urquhart Castle. Invergordon is your gateway to Loch Ness and the area known as the "Great Glen."

### Tuesday, July 17 - Edinburgh, Scotland (South Queensferry)

You'll want to head to Edinburgh Castle for the best view in town but be sure to also check out Princes Street, the Royal Mile and the neoclassical grandeur of Calton Hill.

### Thursday, July 19 - Paris/Normandy, France (Le Havre)

Le Havre is France's second largest port and the gateway to Paris, "City of Light," the Norman countryside, and the historic landing beaches.
